### **SENIOR OFFICER – RISK ANALYTICS DEPARTMENT**

We seek to hire a full time Senior Officer within the Risk Analytics Department. The Senior Officer is responsible for the completion of risk-related assessments that support internal and external reporting priorities. The risk assessment process will involve identification, assessment, monitoring and action of the risks identified for mitigation.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Conduct comprehensive risk assessments for registrants and licensees of The Commission.
- Analyse various sources of data (i.e. operational or scenario analysis) that contribute to risk assessments or management level reporting.
- Creation of surveys, questionnaires or other source gathering documents as applicable.
- Maintain risk registers, action plans and monitor action points until closure.
- Assist with preparation of management level reports.
- Assist with updating templates used in the conduct of risk assessments as may be required.
- Assist with the preparation and the conduct of risk-related training.
- Able to communicate directly with the registrants and licensees of the Commission.
- Collaborate with technical departments of the Commission for risk-related activities.
- Support management in international regulatory body report submissions, questionnaires, surveys and the like.
- Provide support, training and oversight to junior team members.
- Attend routine or ad hoc meetings and provide support to superiors in the completion of routine or ad hoc projects.

#### **Qualifications/Experience:**

- Bachelor's degree in accounting, finance or risk management.
- 5+ years of regulatory, risk and/or financial services experience.
- Obtained or actively pursuing CPA or CA designation
- CFA, Risk and/or Anti-money laundering (AML)/Compliance qualifications (ICA or CAMs) would be an asset.
- Broad knowledge of capital markets, products, legislation and regulatory environment.
