NOTICE Re: International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Act, Chapter 16 (IOEAMA): ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida

The Securities Commission of The Bahamas (the Commission) advises all licensees and registrants that on 28 September 2026 the United Nations Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) amended the entries of person(s) and/or entit(y/ies) identified in the attached press release SC16465 under ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida.

In accordance with the International Obligations (Economic and Ancillary Measures) Act and the Anti-Terrorism Act, and Orders made thereunder, registrants and licensees are required to: (a) determine immediately whether they hold or control funds or other assets of, or provide services to or for the benefit of, any person or entity identified; (b) freeze such funds or other assets without delay and without prior notice; and (c) refrain from making any funds, other assets or services available, directly or indirectly, to or for the benefit of any such person or entity.

Any match, suspected match or attempted transaction involving a person or entity identified must be reported forthwith to the Commission using the applicable Form ([Targeted Financial Sanctions Reporting Form](#)) accompanying this Notice, without prejudice to any reporting obligation to the Financial Intelligence Unit and the Office of the Attorney General (OAG). All confirmations of compliance should be addressed to: Executive Director, Securities Commission of The Bahamas (SUDfilings@scb.gov.bs).

Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee Amends One Entry to Its Sanctions List

On 28 September 2026, the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities enacted the amendments specified with strikethrough and underline in the entry below on its ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024), and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations.

The group mainly operates in the provinces of Hama, Idlib and Ladhikiyah, in the Syrian Arab Republic, and also conduct operations in Turkey, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan, Russian Federation, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan, Egypt, Afghanistan, Ukraine. The number of fighters of KTJ is about 500. KTJ also cooperates with such terrorist

organizations as Khatiba Imam al-Bukhari (QDe.158) and the Islamic Jihad Group (QDe.119) INTERPOL-UN Security Council Special Notice: <https://www.interpol.int/en/How-we-work/Notices/View-UN-Notices-Entities>.
